- c) Evidence of Registration of Business Premises with Kaduna State Ministry of Commerce, Industries and Tourism.
- d) Evidence of registration with KEPA,
- e) Evidence of Tax Clearance Certificate for the last 3 years (2014, 2015 and 2016) with clearly turn over statement and evidence of remittances,
- f) Company Audited Account for the last 3 years (2014, 2015, and 2016) with clear turn over.
- g) Company profile with list of key personnel in the company employment with their qualification(s) and registration with relevant

- professional bodies and experiences in execution of similar works.
- h) Evidence of equipment owned or leased and technology capacity for the works (where applicable only).
- i) Evidence of verifiable previous completed/on-going works with adequate details and evidence of awards, valuation certificates, practical completion and/or certificate of making good defects.
- j) VAT Registration with evidence of Remittances.
- k) Evidence of Financial Capability and Banking support.
- 1) Letter of authorization for the Ministry to make enquiry on any and/or all the documents submitted.

The prequalification requirements MUST be arranged in manner listed herein; a table of content must be provided and the document paginated and every page signed by an authorized representative of the company.

- b) Financial Bid shall be One (1) original and One (1) copy both in the ONE envelope and marked "Financial Bid " at the top right corner.
- c) These are to be contained in and outer envelope duly marked "Prequalification and Financial Bid: (Title of the Project"). The Bidder's name, address and telephone number should be written on the reverse side of the outer envelope.
