




The 2018 Spending plan is up 0.76% from 2017 budget estimate of N214.92bn










HOW WILL THE GOVERNMENT SOURCE THE LOANS? (EXTERNAL LOANS)






HOW WILL THE GOVERNMENT SOURCE THE GRANTS? (EXTERNAL GRANTS)


