The position of VICE-CHANCELLOR of the Kaduna State University (KASU) will be vacant with effect from 23rd January 2022. Suitably qualified and interested candidates are invited to submit their applications.

Job Description

The Vice-Chancellor is the Academic and Administrative head of the University and is responsible to the Governing Council for the day-to-day management of the affairs of the Institution. The Vice Chancellor:

- (a) Provides Leadership on Academic and Administrative tasks to the whole University;
- (b) Represents the University externally;
- (c) Leads initiatives to build the University's financial base to support the delivery of the University's Vision, Mission, Aims and Objectives;
- (d) Carries out certain important ceremonial and civic duties; and
- (e) Is responsible for generating National and International Academic Linkages.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate must be a distinguished academic with vast experience in University Management; with a Ph.D and at least 15 years of teaching and research experience in the University system and must have attained the rank of professor.

The successful candidate must have demonstrable ability and understanding of 21st Century management concepts and practices and application of ICT for cost effective resource management.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

The remuneration and conditions of service are as obtainable and applicable to the post of Vice-Chancellor in the Nigerian University System, and as may be determined by the Council and the Kaduna State Government from time to time.

METHOD OF APPLICATION:

Qualified and interested candidates are required to submit Twenty (20) copies each of application letter and comprehensive Curriculum Vitae (attaching photocopies of relevant credentials) under confidential cover in an envelope sealed and marked **Post of Vice-Chancellor KASU** and addressed to the Registrar and Secretary to Council, Kaduna State University, Tafawa Balewa Way, P.M.B. 2339, Kaduna, Kaduna State.

Applicants are also required to submit Twenty (20) copies of a two-page statement of their Vision and Mission for the Kaduna State University.
